Lintel deployments include 90 links of Eclipse high-capacity radios, which are optimized for networks with flexible, high-bandwidth capabilities and native gigabit Ethernet interfaces. The links extend network reach into remote areas across the two countries, as well as increase network reliability. The Eclipse platform, well known for a number of market firsts for TDM wireless transport, including Super-PDHTM transport and compact nodal networking, will enable Africell to achieve a stable, nationwide, independent backbone in both countries.
